How to find us in Bellevue:

Northbound and Southbound

- From I-405 South take the NE 8th Street Exit heading East
- At the light, which is 116th Ave. NE, take a left turn – go 1/8 mile
- From I-405 North take the NE 4th Street Exit heading East
- At the light, which is 116th, take a left turn – go 3/8 mile
- Turn left into the Overlake Hospital Complex
- Go to the Parking area in back of the Medical Tower to park
- Tell the attendant that you are there for a CACS exam
- Proceed into the hospital entrance, turn left into the Medical Tower
- We are located on the 2nd Floor, Suite 260, East of the Elevators

Regardless of your test results, everyone should know the warning signals of a heart attack. If you feel any of these symptoms, see your doctor or visit the emergency room immediately:

- Uncomfortable chest pain, fullness, pressure or squeezing
- Pain spreading to the shoulders, neck or arms
- Chest discomfort with lightheadedness, fainting, sweating, nausea or shortness of breath
- Sudden numbness or weakness of face, arm or leg, especially on one side
- Sudden confusion, or trouble with speaking, understanding, walking, balance or sight
- Sudden severe, unexplained headaches
